2020 Commencement

UPDATED - 5/28/20

1. Commencement will be held rain or shine on **Thursday, June 4th at 7 PM**, in the south parking lot of the high school, facing the baseball field.

2. The ceremony will be **broadcast live on WBVP and live-streamed on Facebook Live** by the station. In order to adhere to guidelines, set by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, the parking lots and campus will be closed to the public during the ceremony. Beaver Falls Police will be on-hand to assist with your safety.

3. Some students **will enter school district property** at 15th street behind the Central Elementary entrance while some will enter at the 20th street entrance to Tiger Alley.

All students will be designated an entrance location. Individual entrance locations will be posted to www.tigerweb.org on June 2 and emailed directly to all seniors.

Seniors will **park in assigned spaces** in the south faculty and flag pole lots along Tiger Field. Principals and teachers will guide students into their spots. Parking spot numbers will **not** be provided to students ahead of time.

Students are encouraged to **decorate their cars**; however, it must be stressed that they **remain in their vehicles** until they are called to the stage.

4. There will be no tickets for family members. Each graduate may bring as many family members as will fit into a **standard vehicle**. Only the graduate will be permitted to exit their vehicle during the ceremony. **All other family members must remain in their car**. Bathrooms will be available behind the middle school for emergencies.

5. A **stage will be set up** along the Tiger Field's right field baseline to conduct the ceremony.

6. When it is time to receive their diplomas, seniors will be called in socially distanced groups, to the stage. **Principals and teachers will direct the seniors to the stage**. School representatives will hand the seniors their diplomas with no physical contact.

A school district representative and professional photographer will be on hand to take pictures as the senior accepts his/her diploma. **Pictures taken by the school representative will be distributed electronically free of charge**. Families will have the opportunity to purchase additional photos from the professional as well.

Family members and/or friends are not permitted to accompany the senior to the stage, nor can a family member and/or friend exit their vehicle to take pictures.

Students will then be guided back to their vehicle while continuing to socially distance.

7. When the command to move tassels is to be given, all seniors will exit their vehicle and stand on the orange paw print painted on the ground in front or behind their designated parking spot. The paws painted in the lot all mark proper social distancing.

Students will then re-enter their vehicle. For the safety of the seniors, families and staff, we ask that do not throw your cap.

8. When the ceremony is complete, principals and teachers will assist with lining cars up properly behind the emergency vehicles for The 2020 BFHS Commencement Parade. The valedictorian, salutatorian, and highest honors students will lead the parade. All remaining students will line up alphabetically.

9. All senior vehicles will remain behind emergency vehicles and proceed down 8th avenue. The parade route will continue by turning left at the post office and left again onto 7th Avenue. The remainder of the parade will be throughout the business district. Therefore, the parade will continue up 7th avenue and end at 20th street.

Seniors are then to continue driving to their next destination.

IMPORTANT NOTE PERTAINING TO WEATHER:

Commencement will be held regardless of the weather. A tent will be set up over the stage in the event of bad weather with a canopy set up over the diploma receiving area.

If weather becomes too harsh to proceed, the ceremony will be delayed until we can proceed.
